Feintool Statement concerning the Restriction of Hazardous Substances REACH¹

Dear Madams, dear Sirs,

The Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 (REACH – Regulation) is a European-Chemicals-Regulation, that entered into force on 1. June 2007. As an EU regulation, REACH is equally and directly applicable in all member states.

Feintool System Parts Sachsenheim GmbH (hereafter referred to as FT) assures to the best of its knowledge, that the products delivered to our customers comply with the above-mentioned regulation in the following manner:

Art. 59 REACH:

With reference to the latest update of the candidate list on 27th June 2024, FT does not use so-called candidates (SVHC - substances of very high concern²) above the 0,1% w/w threshold³. Therefore, there is no obligation to notify customers (Art. 33 REACH).

Title VII REACH:

FT does not use any substances that are listed in Annex XIV (substances subject to authorisation) – regardless of whether authorisation for these substances exists or not.

Annex XVII REACH:

FT does not use any substances that are listed in Annex XVII REACH, insofar as the prohibitions and restrictions apply.
